CARGO CONTROL CHECKLIST

BEFORE LOADING	
EXAMINE THE TRAILER	- is the size and type appropriate?
CLEAN THE TRAILER	- No dirt, water, or debris.
☐ LOADING EQUIPMENT READY	- Forklift, pallet jack, etc.
☐ SECUREMENT METHOD	- Direct or Indirect? Chains, Straps, or both? WLL?
QUANTITY REQUIRED	- How many chains/straps are needed?
□ PROTECTION EQUIPMENT	- Are Corner protectors or Tarps needed?
WHILE LOADING	
☐ REMEMBER MAX WEIGHT	- How much can the trailer support?
□ LIGHT ON TOP	- Keep lighter cargo on top of of heavier cargo.
☐ KEEP THEM CLOSE	- Limit space between cargo.
☐ KEEP IT EVEN	- Make sure straps extert equal pressure.
☐ CHECK YOUR STRAPS/CHAINS	- Make sure straps or chains are in working condition.
CHECK THE CARGO	- Check points of contact and make sure nothing is squished.
ON THE ROAD	
☐ CHECK ON YOUR CARGO	- Check straps/chains when resting or getting gas.
CHECK AFTER EMERGENCIES	- Immidiately check cargo after slamming breaks or veering.
☐ RE-EVALUATE SECUREMENT	- After unloading, reaccomodate straps/chains to new weight.
☐ TAKE IT EASY	- Drive carefully, watch surroundings, keeps an eye on traffic.
