



# HOW TO USE WINCH STRAPS: PART 1



Toss the fabric end of your strap over the flatbed load

Lock the flat hook onto your truck's rub rail.

Do NOT secure the straps on the OUTSIDE of the rail.

Instead, keep the winch straps INSIDE the rail so the straps will not be exposed to abrasion during an accident.

Thread the polyester webbing through the slot at the top of the winch

# HOW TO USE WINCH STRAPS: PART 2

Manually rotate the winch in order to add tension to the strap & secure your load.



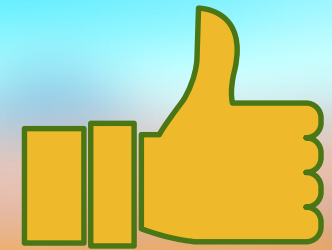
To add even more tension, get more leverage with a winch bar.



Store straps on a strap winder instead of leaving them on the winch itself, to prolong the straps' life.



Keep straps in a dry, protected space when you're not using them, such as a tool box or step box.



Finally, **ALWAYS** use enough straps to fully support your load. Never exceed a winch strap's working load limit.
